


**Suggestion:** Some students demand a national conference in drug abuse.

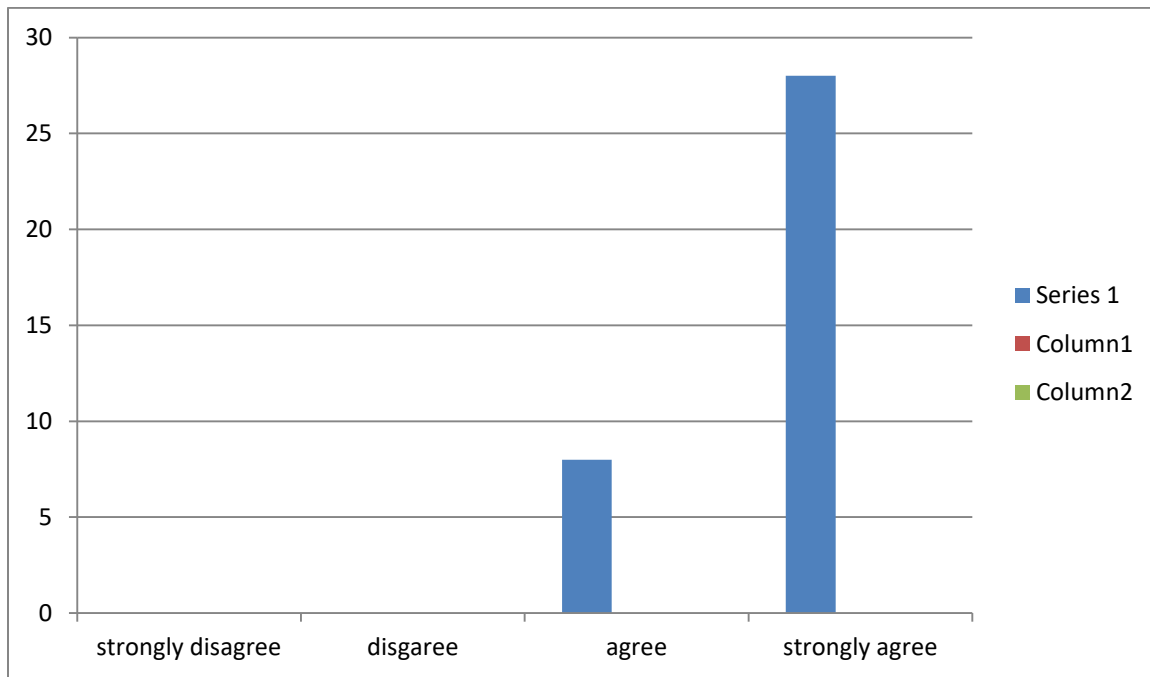

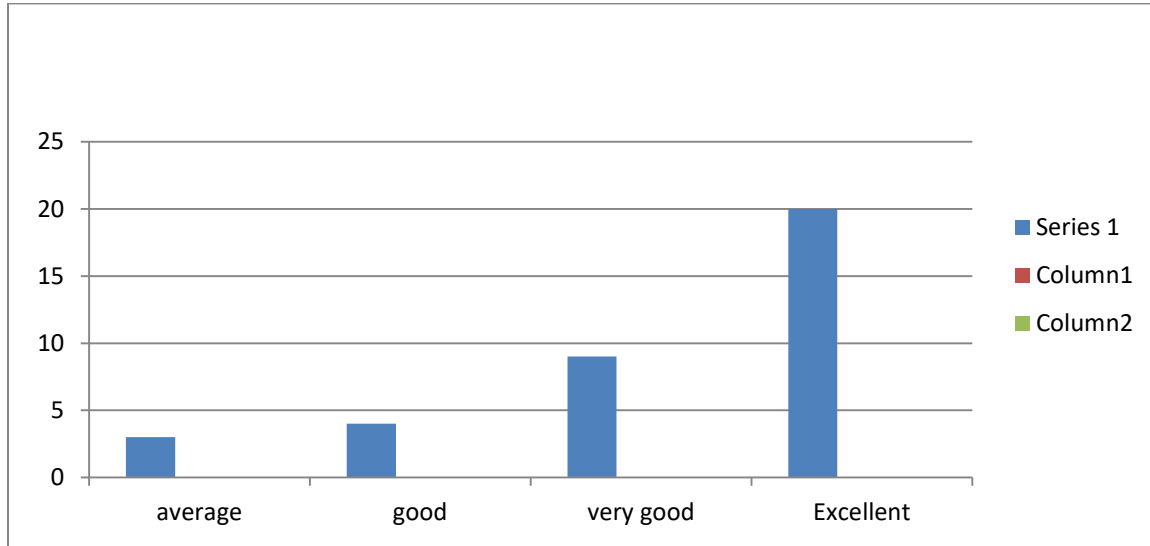
The data suggests that the curriculum designed by the university is upgraded; posses balance between theory and applications and help the faculty in increasing their interest and knowledge towards the subject.



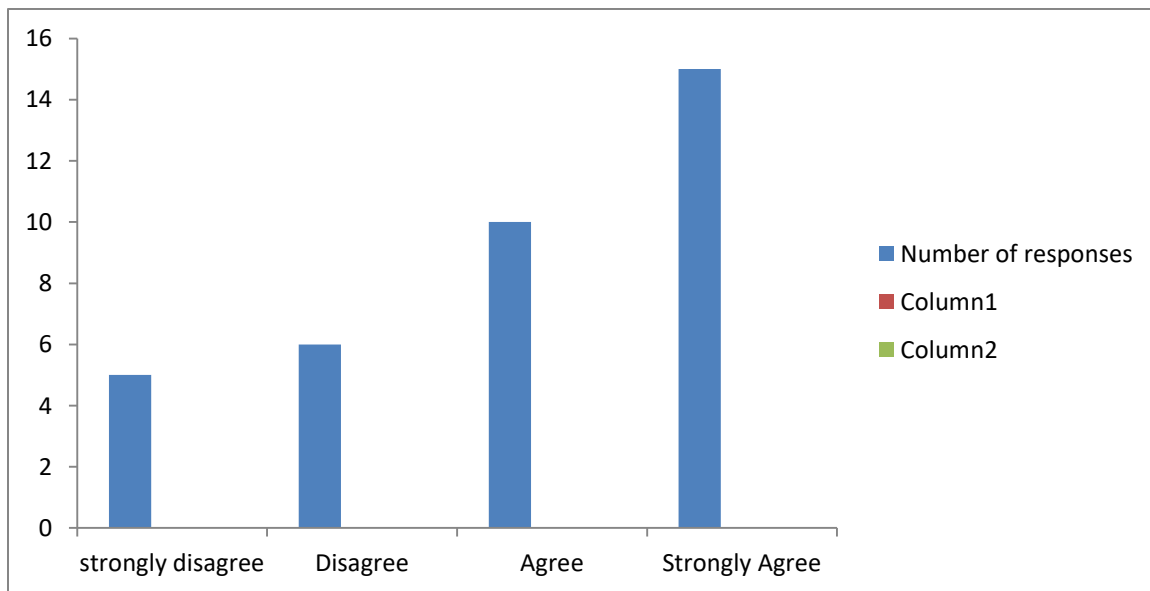

Out of 36 responses 28 faculties has given maximum ranking and rest 8 faculties responded as agreed i.e.4 marks the responses suggests that the Institution provides sufficient freedom to faculties towards adapting new and innovative techniques



Question 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 12 of the questionnaire indicates about the teaching infrastructure available in the college which includes library, IOT facilities and environment for research. Out of 36 faculties 33 faculties rated that the facilities are satisfactory rest 3 faculties are not fully satisfied with the facilities available in the institution.



Question no 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> asks question about the other facilities related to hygiene and refreshment facilities available in the college. We have received mixed responses from the faculties present in the college. Out of 36 faculties 25 made responses that the cleanliness in the college premise with respect to classroom and toilets is up to the mark i.e. they gave 5 and 4 marks out of 5, 11 faculties said that they are not fully satisfied with the cleanliness they gave 3 and 2 out of 5, 6 faculties are unhappy with the maintenance of classrooms, canteen and toilets.



## Conclusion



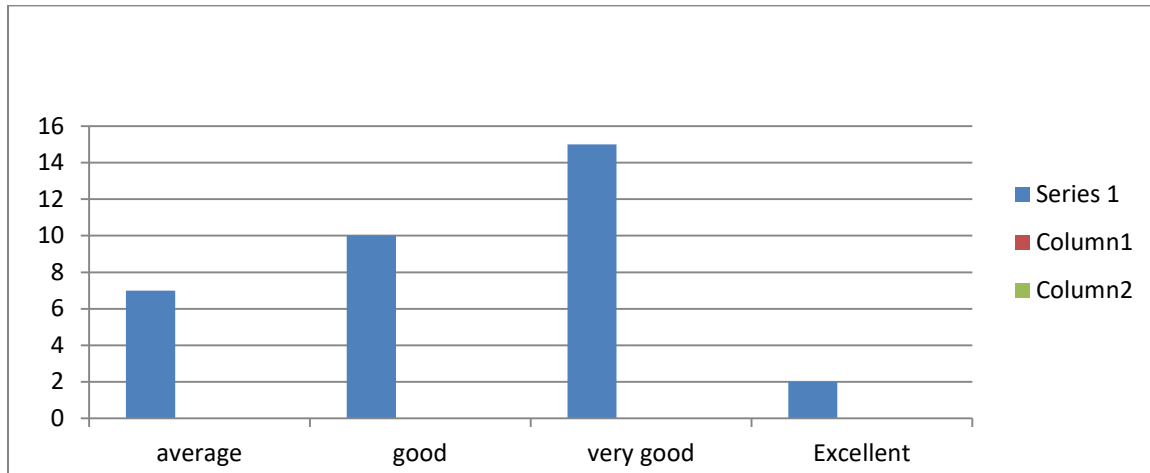
The data suggests that the curriculum designed by the university is upgraded; posses balance between theory and applications and help the faculty in increasing their interest and knowledge towards the subject.



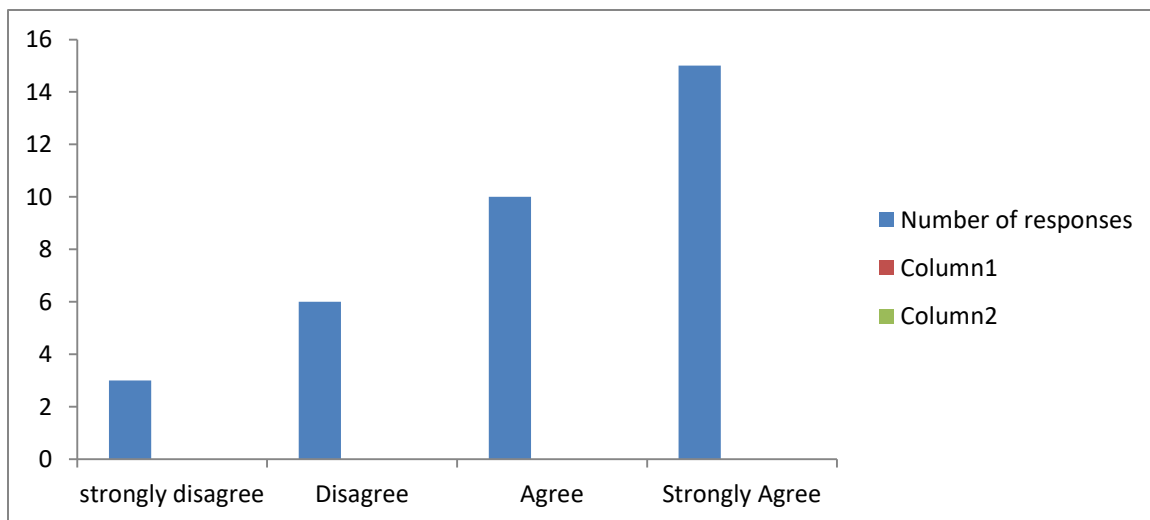

Out of 34 faculties only 2 faculties have responded that infrastructure available in the institution are excellent, 15 have rated 4 points i.e. very good,10 faculties rated that the facilities are satisfactory rest 7 faculties are not fully satisfied with the facilities available in the institution.



Question no 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> asks question about the other facilities related to hygiene and refreshment facilities available in the college. We have received mixed responses from the faculties present in the college. Out of 34 faculties 25 made responses that the cleanliness in the college premise with respect to classroom and toilets is up to the mark i.e. they gave 5 and 4 marks out of 5, 6 faculties said that they are not fully satisfied with the cleanliness they gave 3 and 2 out of 5, 3 faculties are unhappy with the maintenance of classrooms, canteen and toilets.



## Conclusion



Although there is improvement in the facilities viz. water purifier, air condition in the staff room etc. more reforms is required in the infrastructure in the college for example ICT enabled classrooms, up-gradation of library etc. The number of faculty post sanctioned in the college is quite less in accordance with number of students in the college, thus request for sanctioning more faculty post must be sent to competent authorities so that the quality of education can be improved.

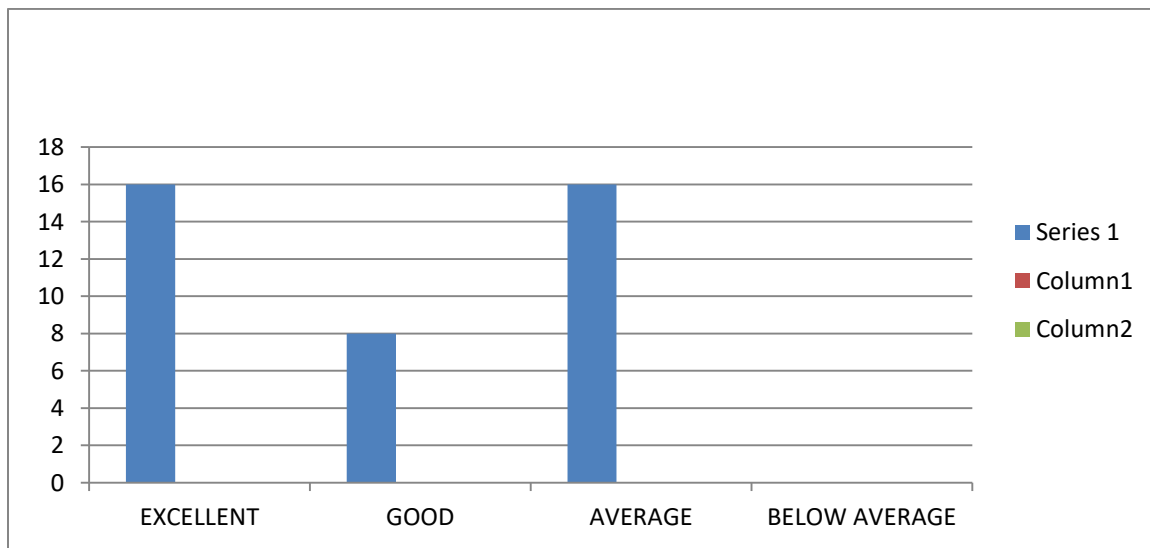
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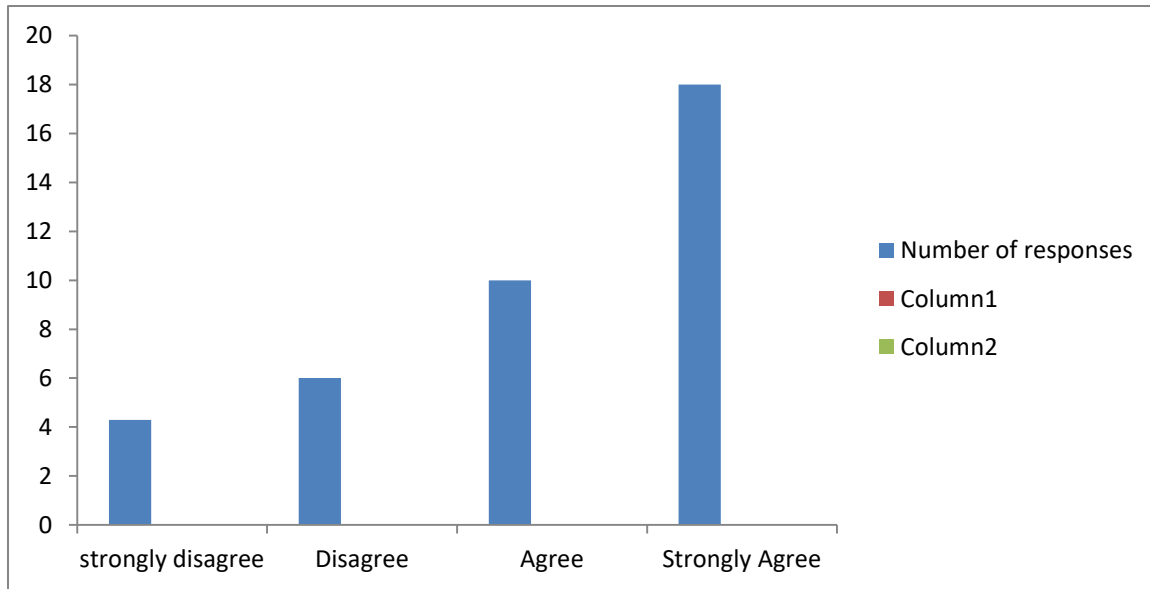
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### Conclusion
