
A motivated worker is the back bone for any organization especially for service industry like Education it becomes sine qua non as the quality of education depends directly upon the teacher's attitude towards their organization.



The data suggests that the curriculum designed by the university is upgraded; posses balance between theory and applications and help the faculty in increasing their interest and knowledge towards the subject.



The data suggests that the curriculum designed by the university is upgraded; posses balance between theory and applications and help the faculty in increasing their interest and knowledge towards the subject.







Question no 13th, 14th and 15th asks question about the other facilities related to hygiene and refreshment facilities available in the college. We have received mixed responses from the faculties present in the college. Out of 34 faculties 25 made responses that the cleanliness in the college premise with respect to classroom and toilets is up to the mark i.e. they gave 5 and 4 marks out of 5, 6 faculties said that they are not fully satisfied with the cleanliness they gave 3 and 2 out of 5, 3 faculties are unhappy with the maintenance of classrooms, canteen and toilets.



Conclusion

In the teachers feedback analysis for the year 2016 -17 we have found that the teachers are demanding research related activities in the institutions. Although there is improvement in the facilities viz. water purifier, air condition in the staff room etc. more reforms is required in the infrastructure in the college for example ICT enabled classrooms, up-gradation of library etc. The number of faculty post sanctioned in the college is quite less in accordance with number of students in the college, thus request for sanctioning more faculty post must be sent to competent authorities so that the quality of education can be improved.




Question 5th and 6th of the questionnaire is related to freedom given to faculties in adopting new techniques and innovation to make teaching learning process more interactive, interesting and result

oriented. 88% faculties have strongly agreed and 12% faculties responded as agreed. The responses innovative techniques/strategies.


